On May 15<sup>th</sup>, The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) provided updated guidance on: <a href="#">mask use</a>, <a href="#">vaccinated persons</a>, <a href="#">isolation and quarantine</a>, and <a href="#">travel related quarantine</a>.</p>
